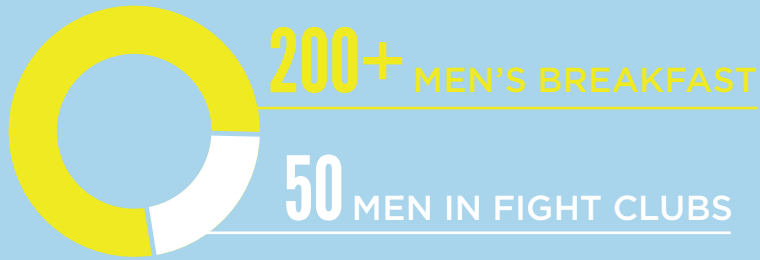
RUSH CREEK KIDS

We have contributed to Hope Coffee's 2016 campaign of 18 shelter projects and 16 water projects.

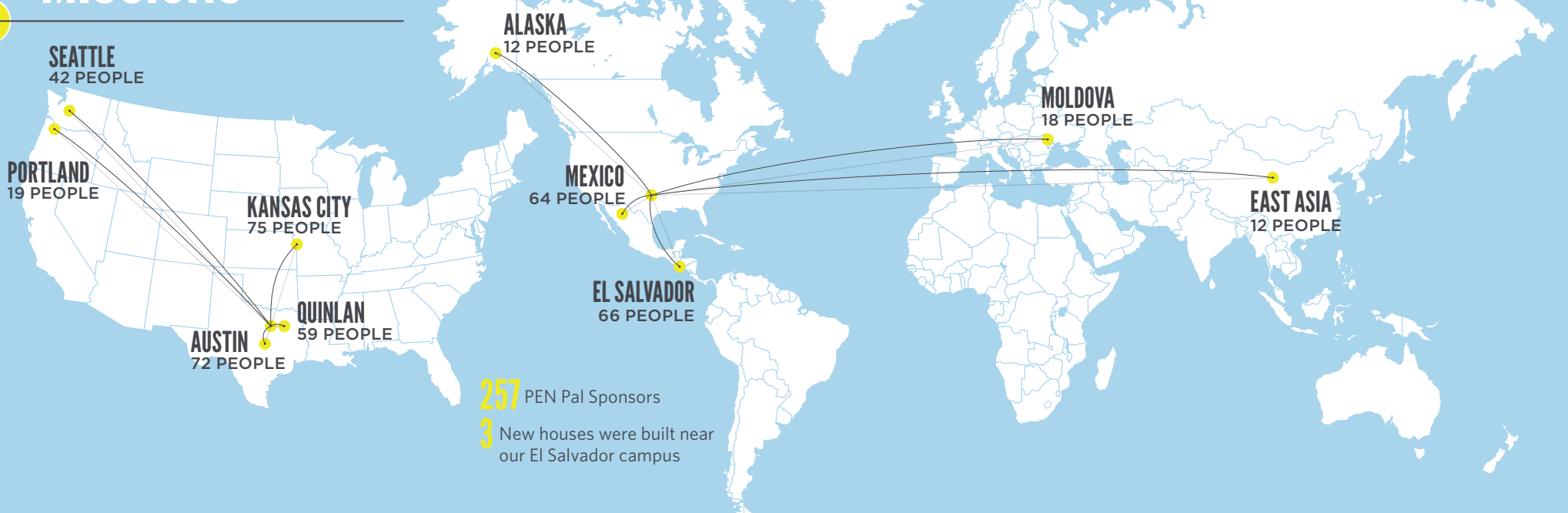
REAL LIFE MINISTRIES

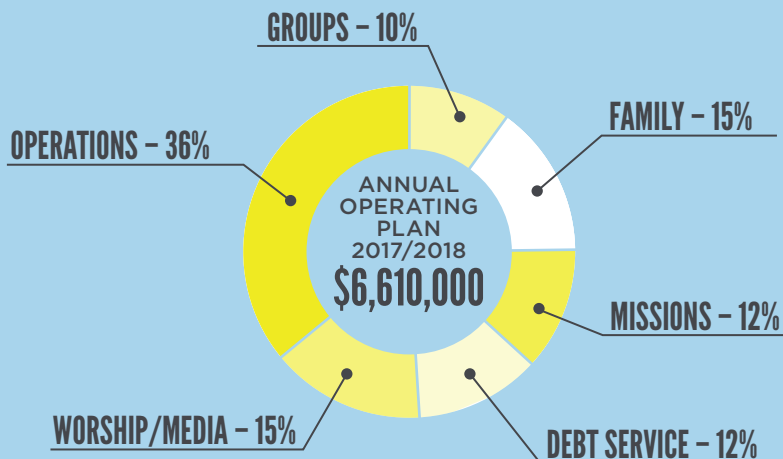


SERVANTS
