THE TEXT: WHAT DOES IT MEAN FOR ME?

ASK THIS:

In your view, who is the worst person:

The one who takes a life because he likes killing.

The parent who abuses their child because they cannot control themselves.

The fund manager who steals thousands of families' retirement savings and is barely remorseful.

Defend your choice.

- Saul/Paul was a powerful man and before he met Jesus the early church was afraid of his reputation. Share with the group some things in your character that you believe those around you would say make them "afraid" of you.

- Paul used his past failures to propel him to a life of struggle, persecution, and prison for the Gospel of Jesus. What could your past failures propel you to go and do? What is standing in your way?

- In Acts 9:1-18 Saul/Paul had a life-changing encounter with God. Have you had a life-changing encounter with God at any point in your life? Share it with the group.



- Go back to the 1st question. In God's eyes where do you rank among the three options? At the top, about the same, or worse? What hope can you find in Jesus?
