THE TEXT: WHAT DOES IT MEAN FOR ME?

ASK THIS:

- Doubt robs our peace. Share with the group an experience when you had no peace because of doubt.
- Thomas is known to those who study Scripture for his doubt. In America some might use the word skeptical. For some, being skeptical is celebrated. Why do you think many in our society celebrate skepticism?
- Wrestling with doubt can be productive when in a community of friends. However, fear of confrontation seems to be a paralyzing fear in America. The notion of wrestling with doubt in community can be a bit foreign. Why do you think discussing doubt among friends has become so foreign?
- We read in John 20:24-25 that Thomas was discouraged from the events of Jesus' death and isolated from his community. This could have been a major contributor to his doubting Jesus' resurrection. How could his doubt have been addressed if he had been in community?
- How does your community help you process doubts? Has it helped you strengthen your faith? In what ways?
