THE TEXT: WHAT DOES IT MEAN FOR ME?

Read Mark 1:21-28

- The crowd in this passage used the words "astonished" and "amazed" to describe the authority of Jesus' teaching. What is the difference between Jesus' teaching and that of the religious leaders?
- How does Jesus' authority in this situation contrast with what the crowd normally experienced with their teachers?
- What do you think caused the man, with the unclean spirit to cry, out in the Jewish synagogue?
- Why do you think Jesus rebuked the man with the unclean spirit, even though he was speaking the truth?

Read Jeremiah 23:1-2, Isaiah 1:23 and Ezekiel 34:1-8

- What do these passages reveal to you about Israel's Old Testament system of authority?
- How do these passages help you understand why the crowd in Mark 1:21-28 was astonished and amazed at Jesus' authority?

Read Genesis 3:1, Revelation 12:9, Luke 4:6 and Ephesians 2:1-2

- What influence does Satan's authority have in the world?
- What did the unclean spirit in Mark 1:21-28 reveal about Jesus' authority over demons?

Read Matthew 11:25-30 and Matthew 23:1-6

- What does this passage teach us about Jesus' authority?
- In what ways has Jesus' authority differ from the scribes and Pharisees?

Read Romans 13:1-4, Titus 3:1-2

- To what extent do you think we should obey earthly authority?
- How has governmental authority been a benefit to your life?
- In what ways have governmental authority been a hindrance to your spiritual growth?
